- King of England, 1625
- Fights Parliament over issues of money.
- Suspends Parliament, boards troops in homes, and uses martial law in peace time to suspend individual rights.
- Rid England of Puritans and Calvinists
- 1628 – Short Parliament passes the **Petition of Right**.

4. Oliver Cromwell, Lord Protector of the Commonwealth (1649 – 1658)

- In 1649, Cromwell abolishes the monarchy and House of Lords.
