

## WORLD WAR I: PATHS TO PEACE?

**Directions:** Be a demanding reader as you read Woodrow Wilson’s “The Fourteen Points” p. 151-152 (Sherman Text) and excerpts from the hand out: “Treaty of Versailles.” Complete the following tasks after completing the readings.

1. In your own words, summarize each of Wilson’s fourteen points.
2. Create a visual (draw, magazine clipping, clipart, etc) to represent each of the fourteen points.  
*Note: ALL visuals must adhere to TCA standards for appropriateness...if in doubt leave it out.*
3. Compare Wilson’s Fourteen Points to the Treaty of Versailles (Hand out).
  - a. What ideals or values characterize each of the documents?
  - b. What grievances are addressed in the same way by both documents? Which grievances are addressed differently?
  - c. Which document, if followed, would most likely ensure lasting peace between the nations involved? Why?
